



## School Rules

### Expectations

There is one fundamental School rule, namely that all pupils should, at all times, follow the Latymerian Code of Conduct set out below:

### Code of Conduct

- Latymerians behave sensibly, are respectful towards others and their surroundings, and show kindness and consideration at all times.
- Latymerians celebrate one another's differences and listen to one another's ideas and opinions.
- Latymerians engage positively with their learning and strive to do their very best.

The School has a set of rules that are displayed in all classrooms. These rules are shared and discussed with pupils at the beginning of the academic year and are revisited frequently. Pupils agree to abide by the rules to ensure they conduct themselves with common sense, safety and decency, showing respect for others and themselves, and for the fabric and property of the School. Each class may decide on some additions to this list which becomes their class code. This is signed by each member of the form and displayed with the class rules.

- We are polite, kind, respectful and inclusive towards others, in person and online
- We bring our HW diary to School every day and use it properly
- We wear our school uniform with pride
- We are on time and prepared for lessons and always try our best
- We walk quietly and sensibly to and from lessons, and around the school site
- We take care of our own and other people's property and keep our classrooms, lockers and play areas tidy
- We only eat in the dining hall or the garden and playgrounds
- We go outside at break times and play where we can be seen
- We are active bystanders and get help from a trusted adult when needed
- We are honest and take responsibility for our actions
- We recognise that we might make mistakes and we learn from them
- We do not bring any digital devices into school without the School's permission

All pupils are expected to engage positively in the learning process, to work to the best of their ability, to represent the School in whatever capacity when chosen, and to embrace the School's expectations willingly and cheerfully.

These rules apply when at School in and out of the classroom, when representing the School, on School trips and on the journey to and from School, whether or not uniform is being worn.
